Paths to QUALITY Support

- Join Paths to QUALITY**
- Maintain Level 3:** minimum two visits per year, verifying Level 3 standards
- Advance to Fast Track to Level 4** (on or before next annual rating date)

Continuous Quality Improvement

Utilize such techniques as:

- Assessment**—ITERS, ECERS, FCCRS, CLASS, etc.
- Observation**—Teaching practices, classroom management, etc.
- Modeling**—best practices in interactions, implementing lessons, documentation organization, etc.
- Training Follow-up**—what was learned, implementation, how-to
- Goal Setting and Planning**—identify achievable goals, develop action steps, set time lines, be held accountable
- Reflection and Reflective Questioning**—encourages professional to discuss and analyze practice through critical thinking.
- Recognition**—gives encouraging words, advice in troubling situations, acknowledges the small improvements

Analyze and improve practices in:

- Health and Safety**—washing hands, ratio compliance, general management
- Learning Environments**—develop research-based learning centers and materials, behavior management techniques
- Curriculum and Assessment**—link daily activities and lesson plans to the FOUNDATIONS for greater impact on learning
- Family Engagement**—provide families with services that reflect their needs
- Professional Development**—provide goal-oriented training and education to improve practices while meeting accreditation and Paths to QUALITY™ standards
- Adult-Child Interactions**—scaffold questions, feedback loops
